## **2010 ELECTRICAL SERVICE GUIDELINES FOR VENDORS**

**TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF VENDORS, CUSTOMERS,  
VOLUNTEERS, AND STAFF, THE FOLLOWING ELECTRICAL  
GUIDELINES MUST BE ADHERED TO BY ALL VENDORS;**

- Each receptacle at the market is limited to 120V, 15amps (1800 watts maximum). Equipment plugged in to a single receptacle may not exceed 15 amps (1800 watts).
- Undersized extension cords create voltage drops and additional strain on the main service. You must use exterior rated heavy duty extension cords for most equipment; minimum #14 gauge. For cords over 24 feet long, #12 gauge is recommended. All cords must be grounded. Extension cords may be #16 gauge when powering digital electronics only, but must be exterior rated.
- All extension cords must be labeled with the vendors' name.
- Trailers/trucks often require 230 volt or high amperage hook ups which ARE NOT available at the market (see receptacle limitations above).
- You must receive approval from the market management before bringing any new electrical or propane cooking equipment on site. Our electrical service is not equipped to handle heavy duty restaurant equipment ie deep-fryers, ovens, grills, etc.
- Please review the above list and check your equipment before market day to ensure that the market electrical service is not interrupted (breakers tripping etc) on market days.
- Please review these guidelines before purchasing new equipment, trailers, etc. for market use.
- The market staff will continue to audit the electrical requirements of all vendors to ensure that vendors are adhering to electrical guidelines.
- The daily cost of each receptacle use is \$5.
